West Hill Mural

Commissioned by the West Hill Neighborhood Organization of Akron, this 285-foot mural was created to reflect the many distinguishing features of the West Hill area.

The design centers around the typographic message “West Hill Best Hill”—built with a modern typeface, but embellished with Victorian elements — a nod to the unique architecture of nearby homes.

The adjacent landmark Glendale cemetery, served as inspiration for the Gothic flowers, bell tower and nighttime scene. A large donut sun and sprinkle motif pay homage to the neighborhood’s original Krispie Kream store and critters such as ravens and a skink also reflect the landscape of West Hill.
